2. RIDE A BUCK (bare back)
3. TRAIL PLEASURE (flat walk & trail pleasure gait, open tack)
4. BEST JUNIOR RIDER (12 & Under, any gait, open tack)
5. 4 & UNDER SPEED RACKING (English tack, 3 gaits, bell boots allowed)
6. COUNTRY SADDLE (flat walk, slow rack, country saddle rack, open tack)
7. JUVENILE PLEASURE (flat walk, pleasure gait, open tack)
8. FLAT SHOD STYLE RACKING (English tack; show walk, style rack, NO bell boots)
9. COUNTRY PLEASURE (flat walk & country pleasure gait, open tack)
10. GO AS YOU PLEASE (flat walk, favorite gait, open tack)
11. OPEN SHOD SPEED RACKING (English tack; 3 gaits, bell boots allowed)
12. OPEN PACING (open tack; flat walk, slow pace, fast pace)
13. OPEN PACING 17 & UNDER 2x2 STRAIGHT AWAY RACING
14. SPEED RACKING 2x2 STRAIGHT AWAY RACING (open tack, bell boots allowed)
15. SPEED PACING 2x2 STRAIGHT AWAY RACING (open tack)

SPEED & STYLE RACKING MUST USE ENGLISH TACK, OPEN TACK ALL OTHER CLASSES.
NO LEG GEAR IN PLEASURE CLASSES OR STYLE RACKING. CASUAL DRESS.
